**Attention Seniors:** A CSU instructional application workshop will be held on Tuesday, September 22<sup>nd</sup> at 9:00 a.m. in the Clovis West cafeteria. All seniors planning to attend a CSU campus are encouraged to attend. Students planning to attend must sign up in J3.

**Attention Students:** The **PSAT** test date is October 14<sup>th</sup> and **PLAN** test date is October 20<sup>th</sup>. These tests are opinion for all students in grades 9-11. The **PSAT** and **PLAN** test familiarize students with the **SAT** and **ACT** format, it offers test taking strategies, and provides an academic skill analysis. You may sign up for the **PSAT** and **PLAN** test in the library before school, at lunch and after school. The **PSAT** is \$16.00 and **PLAN** is \$15.00 per test and payment is due at the time of registration.

**Attention Seniors:** All seniors planning to attend a **CSU** are encouraged to attend on online application session on October 7<sup>th</sup>. Representatives from **CSU** will be present to assist on completing the application. Students planning on attend need to sign up in J3.

**Attention Seniors:** A representative from **Fresno City College** and **Willow International** will be on campus every other week starting September 22<sup>nd</sup>. Students wishing to see either representative must sign up in J3.

**Seniors:** Meet with representatives from accredited vocational colleges, California State University campuses, community colleges, and University of California campuses and attend workshops on admissions, scholarship and financial aid and much, much, more to help you get a jump start on college.
