The **PSAT** and **PLAN** test familiarize students with the **SAT** and **ACT** format, it offers test taking strategies, and provides an academic skill analysis. You may sign up for the **PSAT** and **PLAN** test in the library before school, at lunch and after school. The **PSAT** is \$16.00 and **PLAN** is \$15.00 per test and payment is due at the time of registration.
