- CSF registration runs this week and next. Please pick up an application from your English teacher and turn it in at lunch in J2.

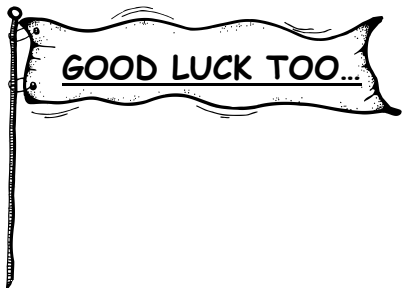
Friday, September 16<sup>th</sup> is the last day to drop a class. Please see your counselor if you have any concerns.
