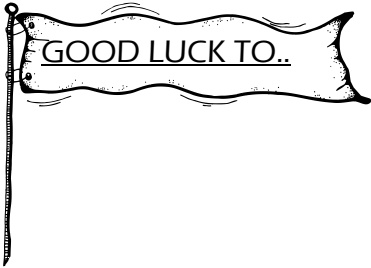
- TOMORROW, Friday, May 25th there will be food booths at lunch. You can start purchasing your tickets from the Activities office.
