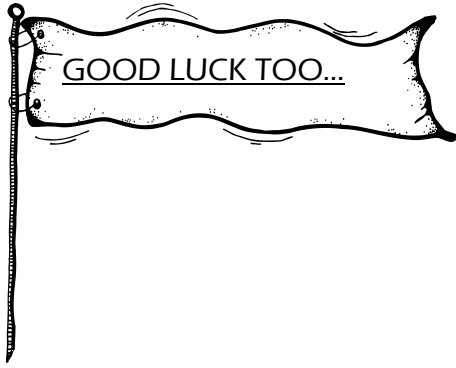
ALL STUDENT ANNOUNCEMENTS
