- Life Teen Meeting in C10 at lunch, come by for food for the body and the soul.

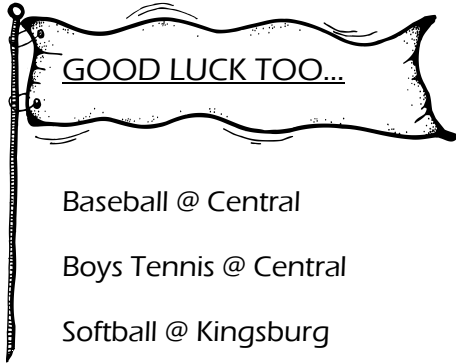
