- Boys Soccer meeting this Wed at Lunch in Lecture Hall.

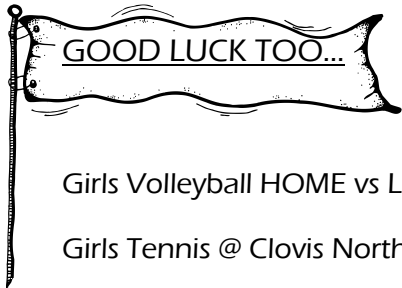
SENIOR ANNOUNCEMENTS
