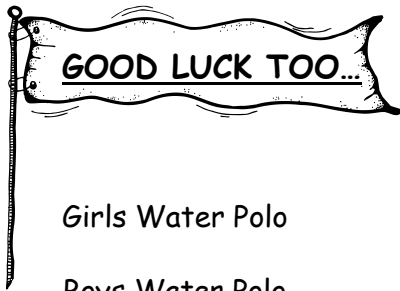
SENIOR ANNOUNCEMENTS
