Future Friday (Occupations). Tell your life story through your costumes.

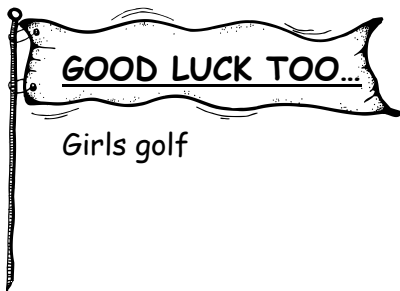
