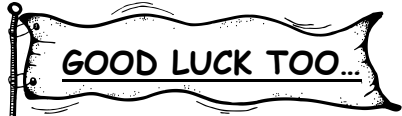
- Starting Oct. 3<sup>rd</sup> both staff and students will be cited for not having parking passes visually displayed in their vehicles.
