New this year! 11<sup>th</sup> grade students take the PSAT for free; no registration required. 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade students pay only \$19.00. PSAT Test Administration is Wednesday October 11 at the beginning of the school day. Not registered, forms are available in the library.
