- Peer Counseling applications for the 2018-2019 school year are still available. Come by C4 and pick one up.

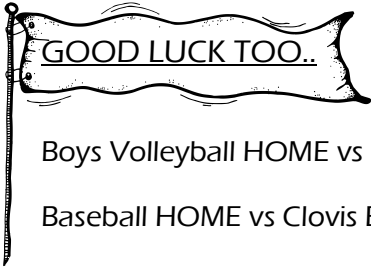
**ALL STUDENT ANNOUNCEMENTS**
