- The Book Hook club meets today in J2 during lunch. This is a fun new club on campus open to all students who enjoy reading. Stop by to join us at our first meeting.

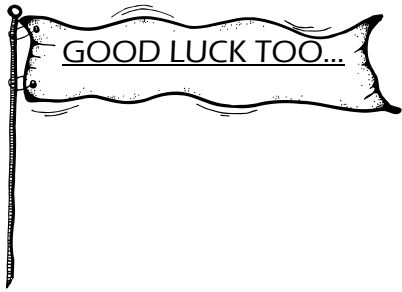
**ALL STUDENT ANNOUNCEMENTS**

Taking this exam will familiarize you with the SAT format and offers test taking strategies; it provides an academic skill analysis and an estimate of SAT composite scores. Taking this practice SAT exam may help in receiving a higher score on the SAT. PSAT scores determine National Merit semi-finalist during the junior year. New this year! 11<sup>th</sup> grade students take the PSAT for free; no

registration required. 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade students pay only \$19.00. PSAT Test Administration is Wednesday October 11 at the beginning of the school day.
