SENIOR ANNOUNCEMENTS

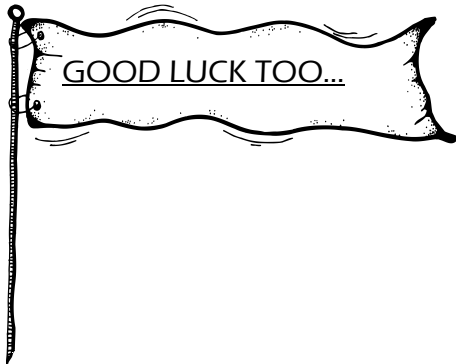
