- We will be having our first Food booth during lunch this Friday. Tickets will be sold starting Wednesday. \$1 = for 1 ticket.

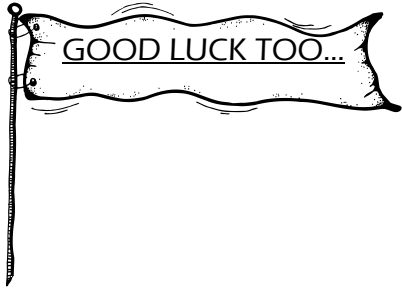
**SENIOR ANNOUNCEMENTS**
