- Seniors! Graduation Speeches are DUE TODAY by 3:00 p.m. in the Activities office with the cover form.

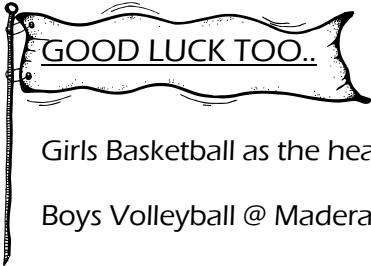
