- There is a Spanish club meeting in P-5 on Tuesday February 14th at lunch. We will have a cupcake decorating contest! Free cupcakes for members!

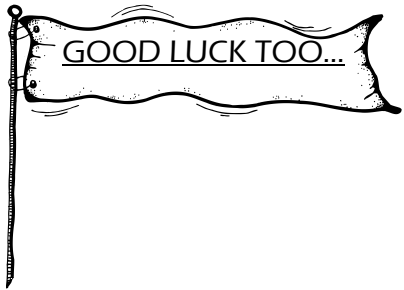
