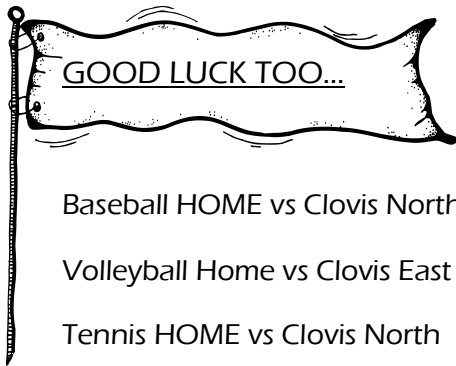
SENIOR ANNOUNCEMENTS
