- Friends of Rachel Club will be meeting at lunch TODAY in E3. Bring a friend and help us plan a fun year to make an impact at CW!

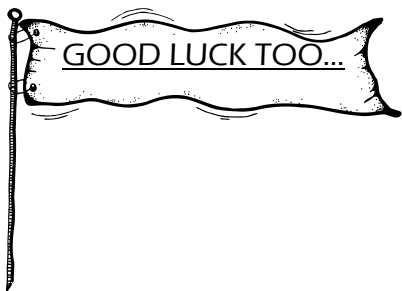
