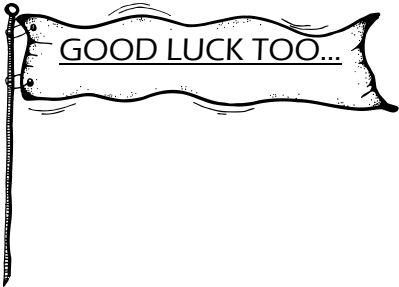
**SENIOR ANNOUNCEMENTS**
