- Link Crew leaders please see Mr. Delgado or Mrs. Bennett to pick up your pass for Club Pictures.

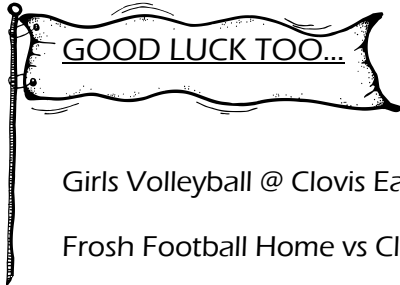
ALL STUDENT ANNOUNCEMENTS
