


Alyssa Gordon Memorial Scholarship

SELECTION PROCESS:

1. Mrs. Brisky will create a three-Member committee with a moderator to screen all application and select the top three (3) candidates.
2. The committee will rank each applicant according to the following criteria:
 - Need: 10%
 - Transcript: 15%
 - Essay/Interview: 50%
 - Co-curricular/Service: 25%
3. Mike and Jean Gordon to determine the winner will interview the top three finalists.
4. **The scholarship award winner MUST attend the Senior Awards Night, Tuesday, May 30, 2018, to receive this award.**
