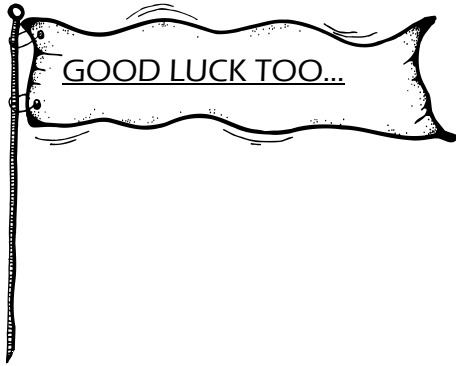
SENIOR ANNOUNCEMENTS
