- Life Teen meeting at lunch TODAY in C10. Come by for pizza for the body and music for the soul.

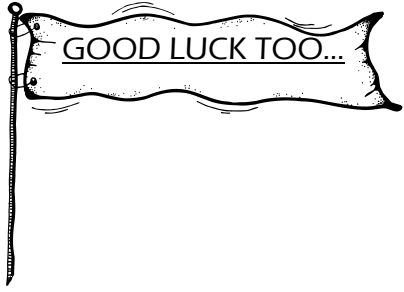
ALL STUDENT ANNOUNCEMENTS
