- There will be a SHORT Academic Decathlon meeting immediately after school today (Tuesday) in P-12.

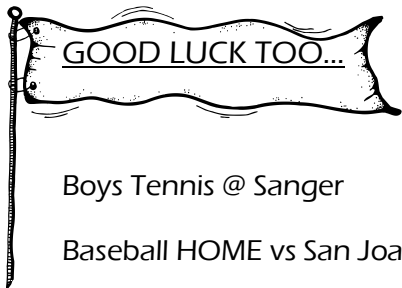
