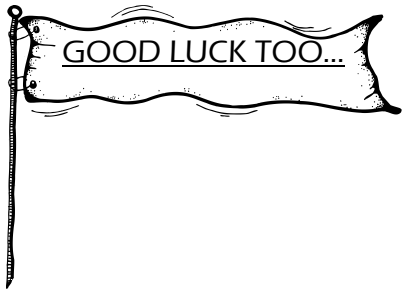
CLUB MEMBER ANNOUNCEMENT
