The Bernice Stiner Careers in Education Scholarship honors a student who has demonstrated steady growth and continuous academic improvement over the course of their education, and participated in school sponsored activities and programs during their high school careers.

The scholarship was created in recognition of the career of Bernice's daughter Janet L. Young, Ed.D. who served as a teacher, administrator, and ultimately Superintendent of Clovis Unified from 2011 to 2017, and to honor the educational legacy of the Stiner family. Bernice Stiner promoted the importance of education through her close to 20-year career as a librarian, during which she helped develop life-changing literacy skills in young people. As a mother, the wife of a teacher/coach and a librarian, she daily advocated for the value of education in transforming lives.

To recognize the valuable role of educators in America, the Bernice Stiner Careers in Education Scholarship recognizes and supports students who will enter college upon graduation from high school in pursuit of a teaching or other education-related degree, and who intend to commit their careers to the field of K-12 education. Qualifying scholarship applicants must be regarded by peers and adults as individuals having strong character, the ability to persevere through life's challenges, a demonstrated care for others, and a strong desire to make a positive difference in their community and the world around them.
