IMPORTANT DATES	Independent Study Summer School BEGINS Tuesday, June 11, 2024 (First week is orientation week) ENDS Wednesday, July 24, 2024 Session 1: June 11, 2024- July 3, 2024 Session 2: July 9, 2024- July 24, 2024 Class will not be held on Wednesday, June 19th ; students assigned to that days meetings will have their appointment rescheduled by the student’s teacher. All student work is to be completed and turned in to the student’s teacher by 5:00pm on Wednesday, July 24, 2024. Tuesday and Wednesday, June 11th, and June 12th Each teacher will schedule a one-hour orientation/enrollment on Tuesday or Wednesday. Any student who fails to meet their teacher on one of the orientation/enrollment days will not be guaranteed admission into Independent Study Summer School.
CLASS APPOINTMENTS	8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m., Tuesday or Wednesday Scheduled weekly appointments: 1-Hour Minimum.
NOTIFICATION	Students should be contacted by their Independent Study Teacher close to the end of the school year. If the IS Teacher has not made contact by June 6 th , please call the Independent Study Office. The Independent Study Summer School phone numbers will be posted on school/district websites.
CREDIT RECOVERY ELIGIBILITY	To be eligible to enroll in credit recovery, a student must be an enrolled CUSD student <i>and</i> meet one of the following two criteria: <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Must be an incoming student in grades 10 – 12 that <u>must repeat a course</u> due to D or F or▪ Must be deficient in credits/required courses for graduation
ORIGINAL CREDIT ELIGIBILITY	Any student who needs an Original Credit course due to employment, an impacted school schedule, or special circumstance. <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Must attend a comprehensive school site.▪ See Counselor who will determine if student meets criteria for Original Credit. For a student to take an Original Credit course in Summer School, the student must meet the following three criteria: <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Have an impacted schedule for the following school year <u>and</u>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Possess a 3.0 or higher Semester GPA (unless otherwise indicated for exceptional circumstances) and ▪ Possess self-discipline, self-motivation, and be able to work independently
POSSIBLE CREDITS	9 th , 10 th , and 11 th grade students may take up to 10 credits (1 full year course or 2 semester courses).
ATTENDANCE	<p>Students may miss only one appointment no matter the reason or emergency.</p> <p>Should a student miss a second appointment, he or she will be dropped. <u>NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE!</u></p>
STUDENT CONDUCT AND DRESS CODE	<p>All Clovis Unified School District rules will be enforced during Summer School including CUSD Dress Code:</p> <p>Conduct: Students are required to abide by the school code of conduct. Students who break the California Education Code are eligible for suspension. If a student is suspended, and the resulting effect is that they miss too many classes as defined by the summer school attendance policy, they will be dropped after serving their suspension.</p> <p><i>Zero tolerance offenses will be referred for further disciplinary action.</i></p> <p>Dress Code: Students are required to comply with the district-wide dress code when attending course appointments. Students out of dress code will be sent home and marked absent.</p>
AGREEMENT FORM	<p>To be enrolled in Independent Study Summer School, the parent/guardian and student must sign a SUMMER SCHOOL AGREEMENT <u>NO LATER THAN JUNE 19th.</u></p> <p>Students will receive the Agreement Form at the first appointment. Any student who does not have a parent's signature by their second appointment will be dropped from Independent Study Summer School.</p>
TRANSCRIPT	<p>Drop Procedures with no credits earned:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Drop before the end of the 1st week: Not recorded on HS Transcript ● Drops after 1st week: Recorded as a NG (No Grade) on HS Transcript <p>Once a course is completed, grades and credits will be posted on the students' transcript. <u>Summer School grade postings are permanent and may not be deleted.</u> Summer School courses may be repeated at the school site ONLY if the grade earned was a D or F.</p>

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Online Courses for Original Credit Summer 2024 information-

Not NCAA Approved

Course will be listed on transcript as Edgenuity course.

Chemistry: 1 year (2 semesters)

Course Prerequisites: Must have A in Biology and currently in Math 2 or higher

Course Requirements: Students must attend class 1 day per week for Lab component of course (3 days online, 1 day F2F) No exceptions.

Semester 1- 60+ hours of Online work, 4 required wet labs, 42 lessons with 180 assignments/plus virtual lab reports.

Semester 2- 60+ hours of Online work, 4 required wet labs, 43 lessons with 187 assignments/plus virtual lab reports and 1 project.

Health: 1 Semester

Course Prerequisites: Meet summer school eligibility requirements (3.0 GPA).

Part A (4 credits)- 40+ hours of Online work, 35 lessons with 184 assignments

Part B (1 credit) 10+ hours of Online, 6 lessons with 29 assignments, CUSD Health presentation

Art 1: 1 year (2 semesters)

Course Prerequisites: Meet summer school eligibility requirements (3.0 GPA).

Course Requirements: Weekly meeting (in person or zoom + 1 meeting every three weeks will be in group setting to share out semester projects.)

Semester 1: 60 + hours of Online work, 44 lessons with 213 assignments/6 projects

Semester 2: 60+ hours of Online work, 47 lessons with 235 assignments/3 projects

PE Elective 1 year (2 semesters) (PE Core not available via Online)

Course Prerequisites: 20 credits of core PE completed with a B or higher, pass fitness test in Spring before Online course.

Course Requirements: 1 x weekly live workout with teacher (Zoom) or in person option

Fitness logs 1x/week.

Semester 1- 50% includes 50+ hours of Online work, 34 lesson with 160 assignments, 50% includes fitness log hours.

Semester 2- 50% includes 50+ hours of Online work, 33 lessons with 155 assignments/1 project, 50% includes fitness log hours.

Social Science (World History & US History)- 1 year (2 semesters)

Course Prerequisites: Overall 3.5+ GPA and an A or B in last Social Science and English courses.

Course Requirements: Check in virtually once a week, same day and same time. Must meet weekly progress goals or be dropped after second missed goal.

World History

Semester 1: 50 + hours of Online work, 56 lessons with 194 assignments/1 project

Semester 2: 50+ hours of Online work, 54 lessons with 188 assignments/1 project

US History

Semester 1: 60 + hours of Online work, 56 lessons with 192 activities/writing project

Semester 2: 70+ hours of Online work, 59 lessons with 211 assignments/1 project

World Languages- Spanish, French, German, Chinese

Course Prerequisites:

Course Requirements: Teacher will provide information

Semester A: 50+ hours of Online work, 90 lessons with 730 assignments, 10 speaking quizzes, 2 speaking tests

Semester B: 50+ hours of Online work, 90 lessons with 614 assignments, 10 speaking quizzes, 2 speaking tests
