


About The Program



Summary:

Bulldog Bound is Fresno State's guaranteed admissions program. It provides high school students from partnering school districts who meet the minimum California State University requirements a guaranteed spot at Fresno State after graduation.

The program ensures qualified students have a clear, tangible path to college. Fresno State will support students and their families with admission preparation as early as ninth grade.

Bulldog,

Please follow the instructions below to submit your photo for your Fresno State ID Card.

Photos must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Submit a color photo, taken in the last 6 months
- 2.Use a clear image of your face. Do not use filters commonly used on social media. No shadows or under exposed photos.
- 3. Have someone else take your photo. No selfies.
- 4. Take off your eyeglasses and hat for your photo.
- 5.Use a plain white or off-white background.
- 6. Have a neutral facial expression or a natural smile, with both eyes open.
- 7. Face the camera directly with full face in view; head centered in the frame and not tilted.

A photo of your government issued identification must accompany your submission. Any photos that do not meet the requirements listed above will be denied and subject to resubmission. However, if you have a medical or religious reason that does not allow you to meet these requirements then please email us at idcard@mail.fresnostate.edu to request an exception.

To submit your photo, click on the Submit Photo link below. Do Not Share This Link!

Please have your photo submitted in the next 7 days. If you have already submitted your photo and have been approved there is no further action needed.






FRESNO STATE LIBRARY

15 courses from A-G:

- 2 years of Social Sciences
- 4 years of English
- 3 years of Math
- 2 years of Lab Sciences
- 2 years of Foreign Language
- 1 year of Visual Performing Arts
- 1 year of College Prep Elective
- Complete courses with "C" or better
- CSU Minimum GPA: 2.0*
- *Program Impaction = Higher GPA for certain programs
- High school graduation or equivalent
